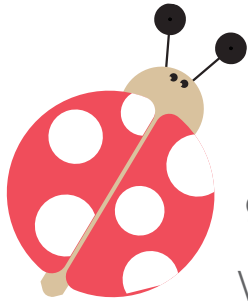

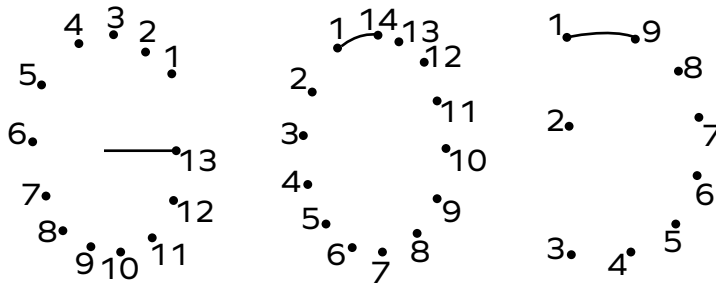

God Has All Power



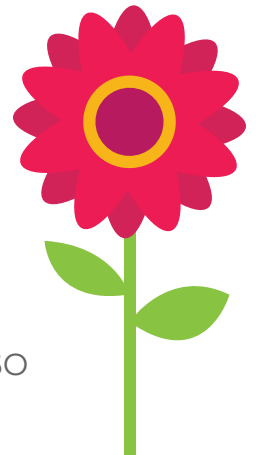
Who made the world? Who made the stars? Who made the lakes? Who made the hills? Who made the lions? Who made the bugs? Who made your grandfather?

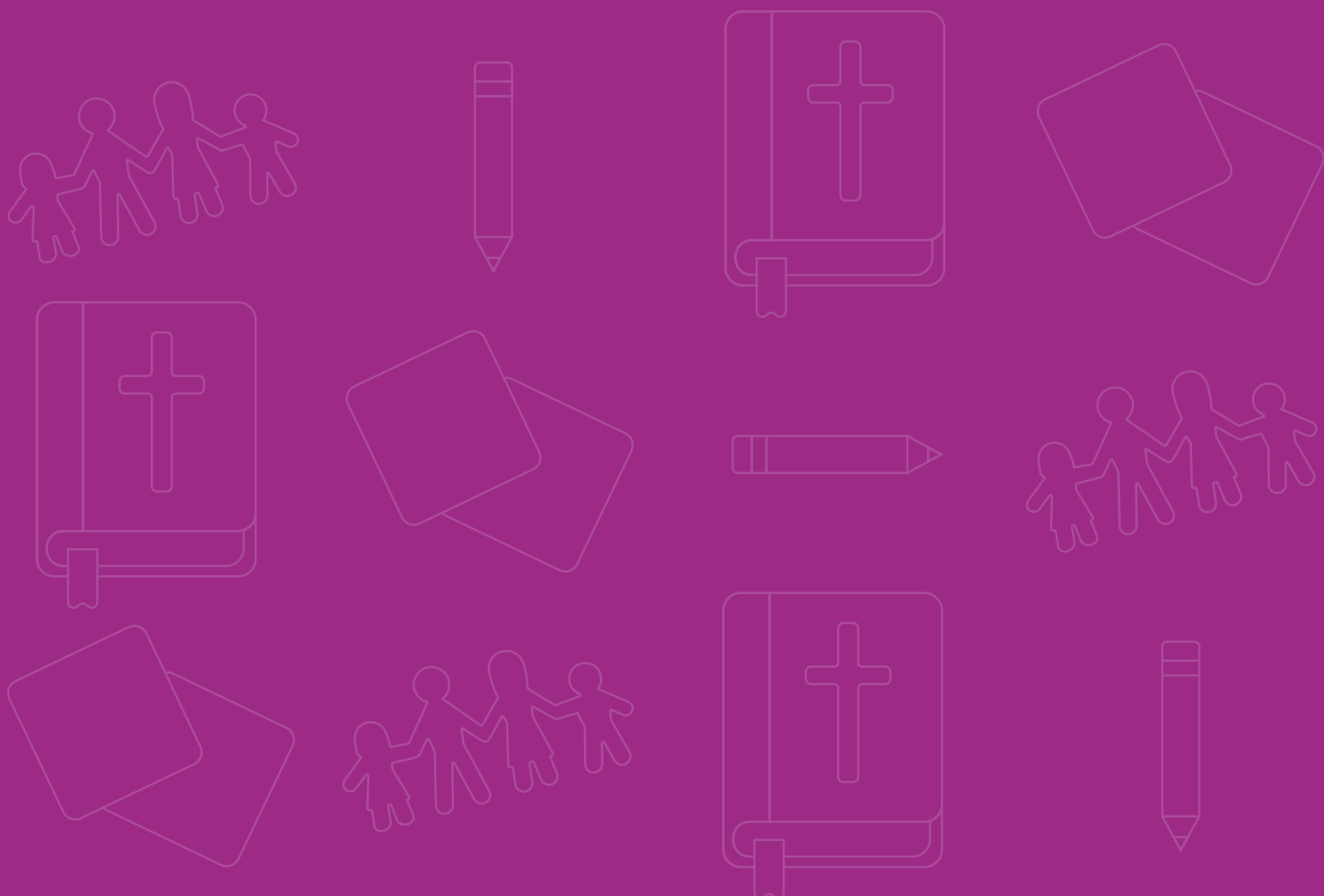
