Every child is different, so care needs to be used and follow them as God may direct them.

Activities: All students and especially young children learn from "hands-on," and we encourage you to do as much as possible as your time permits. A parent should find much pleasure in seeing their little ones in their own special way arrive at new understandings of the Bible. Rejoice with them as they do so.

Scripture Memory: Will serve the children well as they learn and repeat God's Word, and you will be blessed as you see your kindergartner show their skills as they spend time memorizing God's Word.

Grading: At this age, grades are not the most important aspect for kindergarten in Bible. We suggest you discuss with your NFC Academy Kindergarten Resource Teacher how you want to treat Bible when it comes to grading.
